

Identification Points

- 1. Bell Shape: Aurelia has a transparent, umbrella-shaped bell that is typically saucer-like.
- Radial Symmetry: The body of Aurelia is radially symmetrical, meaning it can be divided into equal parts from the center.
- 3. Color: The bell is usually translucent, with a slight bluish or pinkish tint.
- Tentacles: It has long, slender tentacles around the edge of the bell, which contain stinging cells
 called nematocysts.
- Gonads: Underneath the bell, you can see four distinct, typically pink or purple gonads (reproductive organs).
- Oral Arms: There are four oral arms hanging from the underside of the bell, which help in capturing and transporting food.
- 7. Size: Aurelia is relatively large, with some species growing up to 40-50 cm in diameter.
