
Euspongia



Identification Points

- 1. Euspongia is a marine sponge belonging to the phylum Porifera.
- 2. It has a soft, flexible, and porous body made of spongin fibers.
- 3. The body is covered with tiny pores (ostia) that help in water circulation.
- 4. It lacks a nervous system, circulatory system, and organs.
- 5. It feeds by filtering tiny food particles from water.
- 6. It reproduces both sexually and asexually.
- 7. It is commonly known as the "bath sponge" due to its soft texture.
