

Evaluation Procedures and Reforms

Evaluation Procedure:

With the introduction of the Semester system, the Evaluation Procedure has changed to Internal Evaluation and External Evaluation.

The Internal Evaluation is given a weightage of 30% and the External Evaluation carries 70% weightage in assessing the overall performance of the student.

Internal Evaluation – (30Marks)

As part of the Internal Evaluation, two Assessment Tests are conducted and the average of the two is taken into consideration.

- Internal Assessment Test : 20 Marks
- Assignment : 05 Marks
- Attendance* : 05 Marks

Total: 30 Marks

A student should secure a minimum of 12 Marks out of the 30 Marks allocated for the Internal Evaluation.

Marks allotted for Attendance* (as per the percentage of attendance):

If percentage of attendance is	Above 90%:	“O” Grade
	Between 80 & 90:	“A” Grade
	Between 70 & 80:	“B” Grade
	Between 60 & 70:	“C” Grade
	Between 50 & 60:	“P” Grade

External Evaluation: (70Marks)

- Semester-end examination : 70 marks (Pass marks: 28)
- Practical Examinations : 50 Marks (Pass marks: 20)

Guidelines for students:

Students are governed by the rules and regulations framed by the Examination Section of the College.

1. 75% attendance both in theory and practical courses (wherever applicable) is mandatory for candidates to be eligible to appear for the semester examination.
2. After the semester system was introduced, examinations for I, III and V Semesters are held in October/November each year. Examinations for II, IV & VI Semesters are held in March/April every year.
3. All students undergoing regular courses of study have to register for every semester exam by paying the requisite exam fee, filling the examination form and obtaining the hall ticket to appear for the semester-end examinations.

Functions of the Examination Branch:

1. Prepares Academic Calendar for odd and even semesters, examination time table of internal all semesters.
2. Processing of examination application forms and issue of hall tickets which was received from Controller Examinations of Rayalaseema University Kurnool to the students.
3. Conducts the regular semester examinations (both internal & external) and also the backlogs of all semesters. The examination Section looks after the payment of remuneration to the examiners, payment towards stationery, etc., purchased for the examination branch.
4. The Examination Section to receive Question papers from Controller Examinations of Rayalaseema University Kurnool to Conduct as per Schedule also looks after the exams related to the Rayalaseema University and other competitive exams for Govt. jobs conducted by APPSC, SSC, etc.,
5. The Examination Branch issues a semester and Consolidated Memorandum of Marks. Under CBCS, the Memorandum of Marks /Grade Report is issued at the end of each semester to the student, reflecting the marks, credits, and grade letter in each paper.
6. Valuation of the answer scripts are done at the Centers identified by the University in its jurisdiction under the supervision of the Controller Examinations of Rayalaseema University Kurnool.
