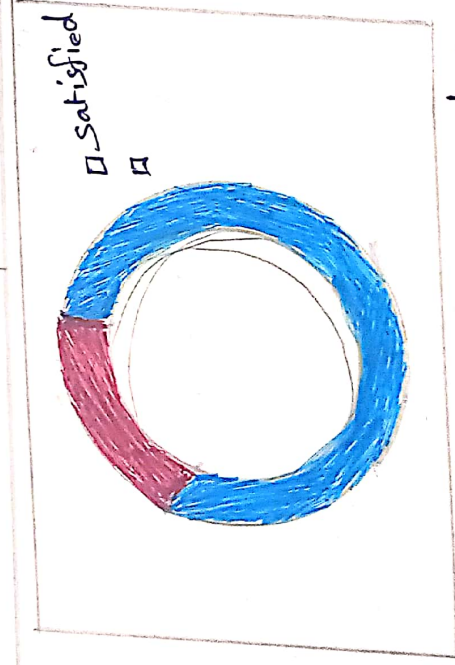

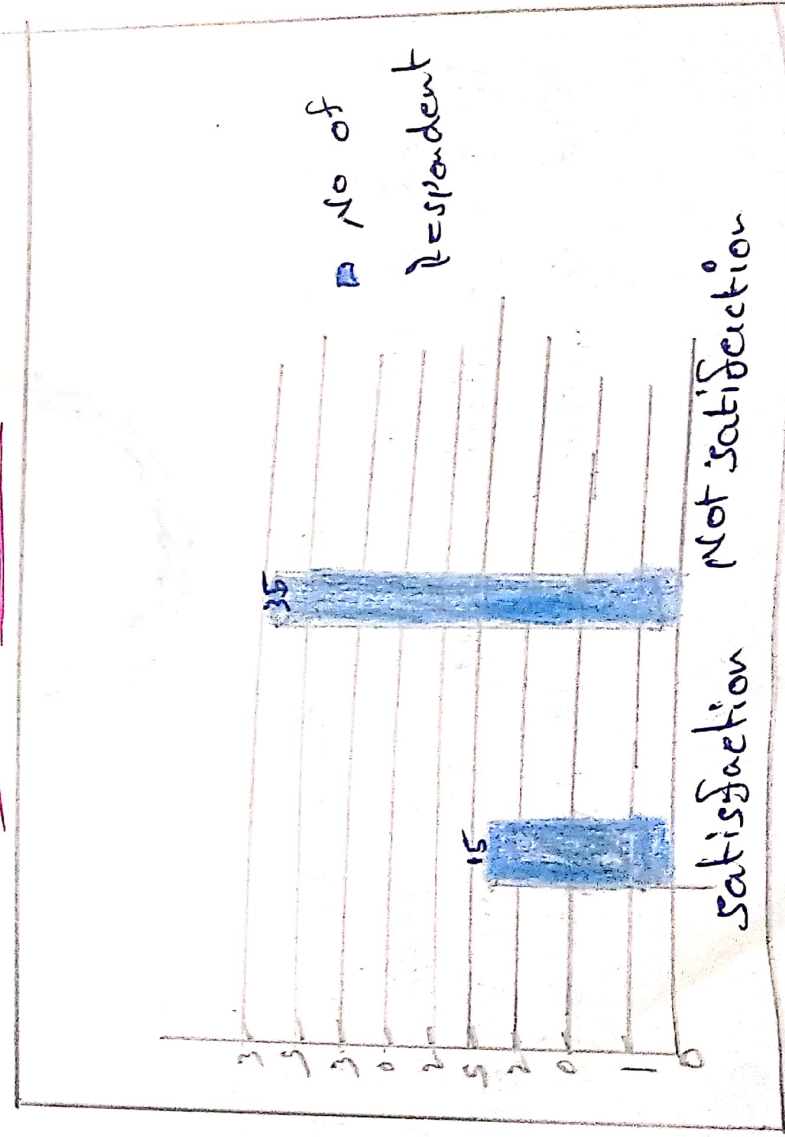

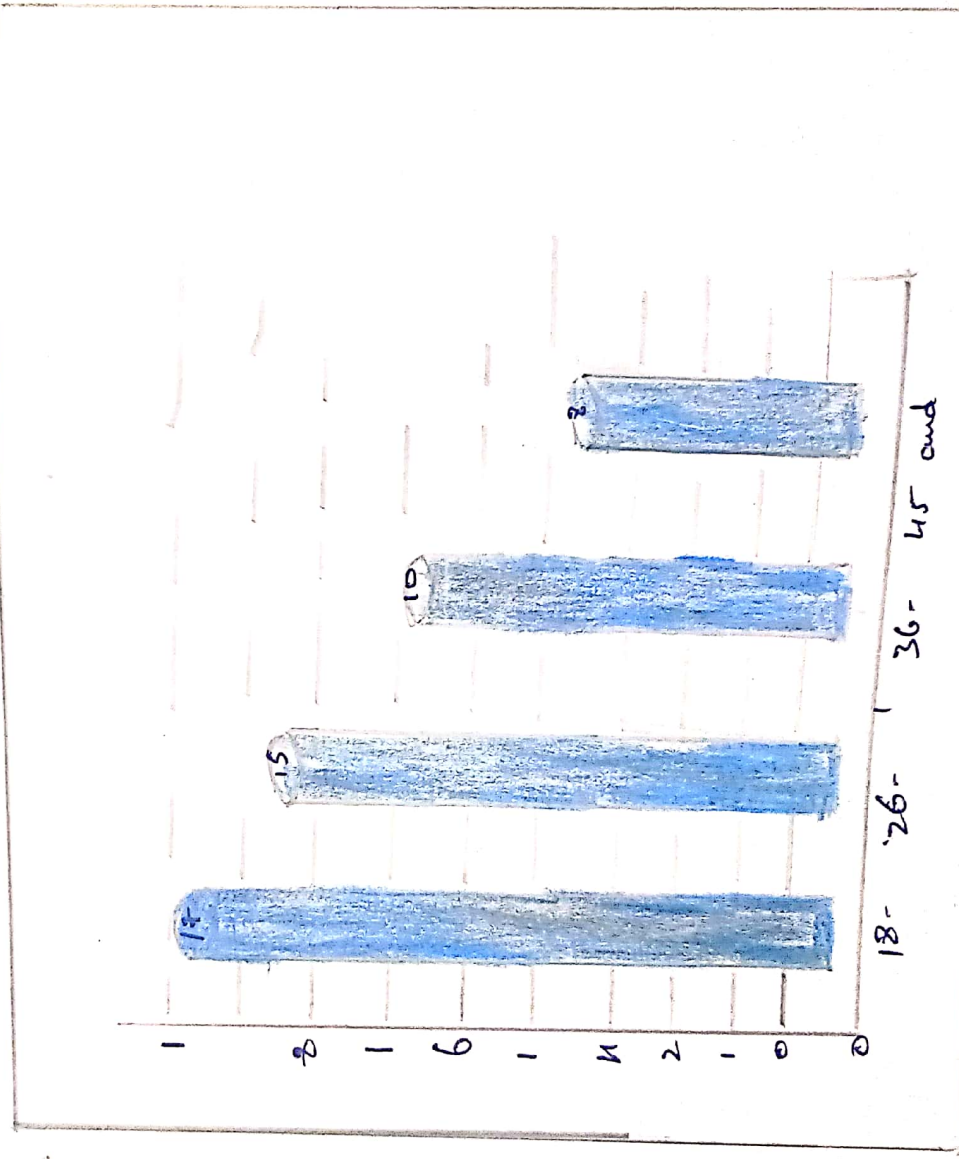

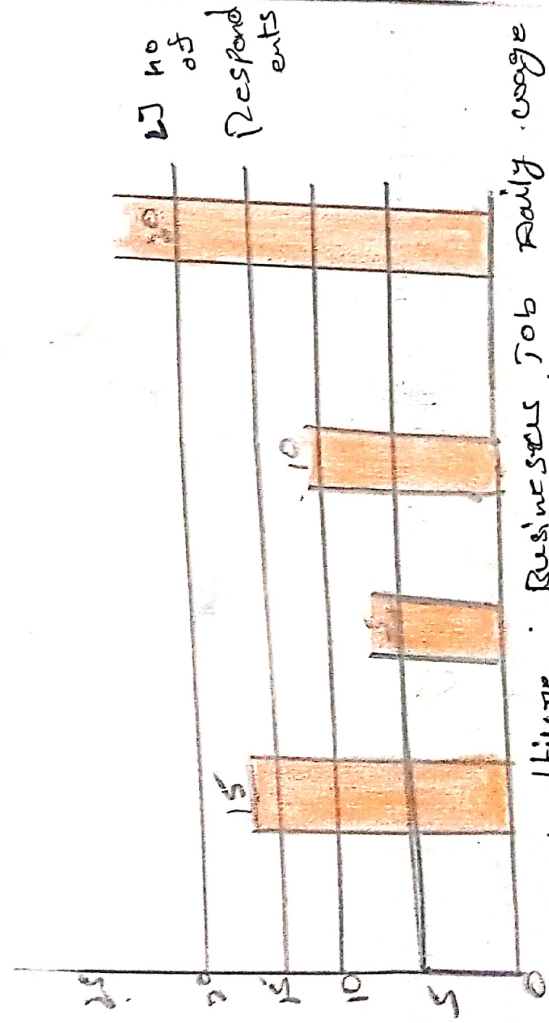

Agriculture Business Job Daily wage

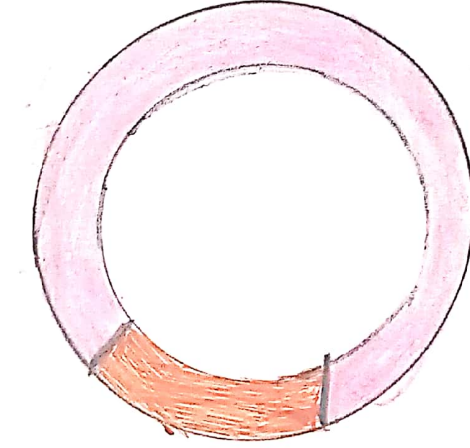

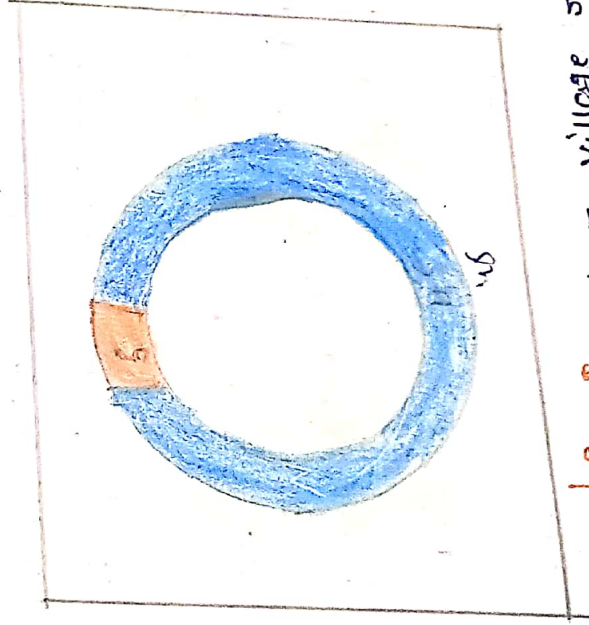

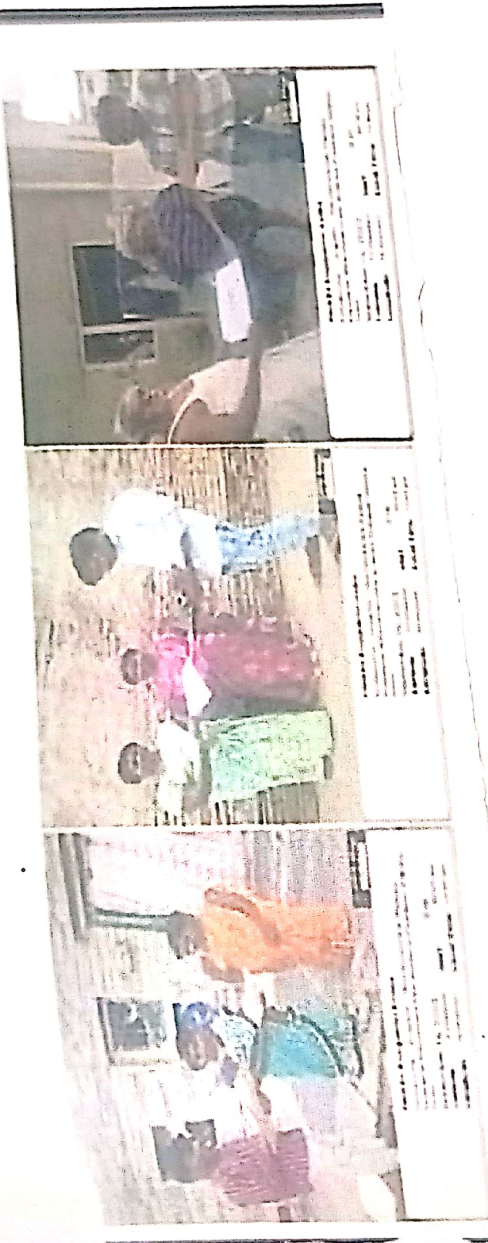
